On July 8, 2009 SGT First Class Mark Allen, a member of the Newnan Armory based Bravo 2 / 121 Infantry of the 48<sup>th</sup> Brigade Combat Team Georgia Army National Guard, was seriously wounded in Afghanistan and suffered a traumatic brain injury. He was being treated at Bethesda Naval Medical Center outside Washington DC and was recently transported to a Medical Center in Tampa, Florida for further treatment. Sgt.
